The learners were really pleased with their results; hopefully everyone can see why?



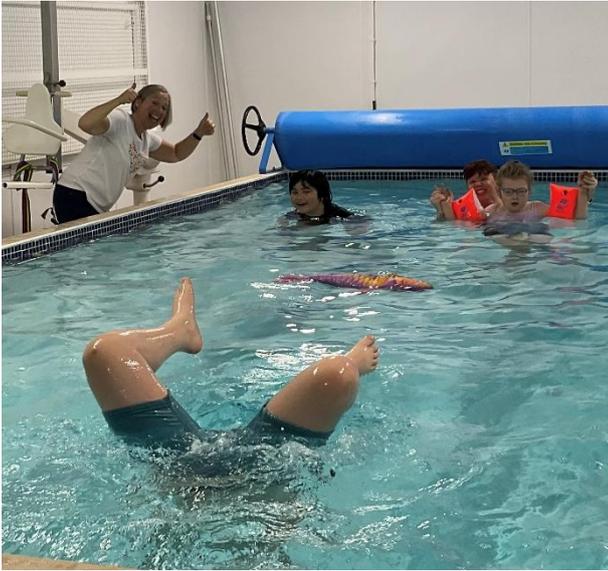

Mobile Phones in School

We want to remind parents and carers that we are a no-phone school. Learners should not have their mobile phone at any time during the school day, which starts as soon as learners enter the school.

We know that learners want their mobile to use during travel to and from school, but phones must be handed in as soon as they arrive. Each class now has a lockable box to store phones safely.

This also extends to wearable devices, such as smartwatches and smart rings; these are not allowed in school at all, not unless there is a valid medical reason for having one, which must be confirmed by an official doctor's letter.

We would very much appreciate parental support on this issue.
